

Stained Natural Wood Pole Finish

Though beautiful in its natural finish, some people prefer to have wood poles stained to match existing architectural features. Douglas fir or cedar wood poles can be stained at the factory during manufacture to provide hues similar to California Redwood, Teak, Oak or other custom colors. While staining poles provides variety, the poles may require some periodic maintenance to re-stain the structure depending on their environment.

Though staining a pole, whether at the factory or at a later date, is a good option to achieve color diversity, painting a wood pole is not recommended due to the inherent preservative treatment and the future needs the pole would require to maintain the painted surface's appearance.
